

RESOLUTION OF THE COLLEGIATE BOARD OF DIRECTORS - RDC No. 650, OF MARCH 25, 2022

(Published in DOU No. 61 of March 30, 2022)

It provides for criteria for the inclusion, exclusion and updating of sanitizing products of lower potential risk manufactured within the scope of MERCOSUR.

The Collegiate Board of the National Health Surveillance Agency, in the use of the powers conferred on it by articles 7, item III, and 15, items III and IV of Law No. 9,782, of January 26, 1999, and considering the provisions of article 187, item VI and §§ 1 and 3, of the Internal Regulations, approved by the Resolution of the Collegiate Board of Directors - RDC No. 585 of December 10, 2021, resolves to adopt the following Resolution of the Board of Executive Officers, as resolved at a meeting held on March 23, 2022, and I, the Chief Executive Officer, determine its publication:

Art. 1 This Resolution incorporates GMC MERCOSUR No. 51/2006, which establishes criteria for inclusion, exclusion and updating within the group of Risk I products selected for the purpose of simplifying sanitary control procedures for products of lower potential risk manufactured in MERCOSUR.

Art. 2 This Resolution comprises sanitizing products intended for cleaning in general and the like, intended for use in objects, tissues, inanimate surfaces and environments, in homes, vehicles, industries and in public or private places or establishments, as provided for in Annex I of this Resolution.

Art. 3 For the purposes of this Resolution, the products must comply with the following criteria:

- 1 - products formulated with substances that do not have proven mutagenic, teratogenic or carcinogenic effects in mammals;
- 2 - products whose pH value, in 1% w/w solution at a temperature of 25° c, is greater than 2 and less than 11.5; and
- 3 - products for cleaning purposes and the like.

Art.4 Products with antimicrobial action , weeds, biological products based on bacteria, oxidants and reducers are excluded.

Art. 5 Will be excluded from the list, products that present unwanted effects, in a systematic way, associated with any health problem.

Art. 6 Whenever it is considered relevant for the protection of the health of the population or the technical-scientific evaluation, the States Parties shall refer to the others proposals for modifications of this Resolution.

Art. 7 The States Parties consulted shall have sixty (60) days to make the observations they deem necessary and forward them to the others.

Art. 8 Finalized the procedure established in the articles. The 6th and 7th of this Resolution, the proposal will be forwarded to the coordinators of the Health Products Commission.

Art. 9 Failure to comply with the provisions of this Resolution constitutes an infraction of a sanitary nature, subjecting the offender to proceedings and penalties provided for in Law No. 6,437, of August 20, 1977, or legal instrument that may replace it, without prejudice to the applicable criminal and civil liabilities.

Art. 10. The Resolution of the Collegiate Board of Directors - RDC No. 37, of June 19, 2007, is revoked.

Art. 11. This Resolution enters into force on May 2, 2022.
